The central focus of a ROSC is to create an infrastructure or “system of care” within the community to address the full range of substance use problems effectively.

About DuPage ROSC

Our purpose is to provide recovery support services to individuals in recovery or seeking recovery from alcohol and other drugs who may or may not have co-occurring mental health issues.

What is ROSC?

ROSC is a coordinated network of person-center community-based services and support. It builds on the strengths and resilience of individuals, families, and communities to achieve abstinence and improve health, wellness, and quality of life for those with or at risk of alcohol and drug problems.

ROSC Goals

The overall goal is to develop an integrated recovery system for those seeking substance use and mental health treatment by involving the community to improve the availability of services. ROSC also seeks to destigmatize substance use and mental health disorders through this shared vision.

ROSC Objectives

- ◆ Promote a healthy and safe community by working together providing resources to improve the health, wellness, and recovery of individuals and families with or at risk of substance use/mental health problems.
- ◆ Develop a supportive recovery community that fosters growth, respect, and understanding of those identified with or at risk of substance use and mental health disorders.
- ◆ Implement an effective peer-led ROSC council. Persons with Lived Experience (PLE) work to inform, educate, and empower individuals and communities. They identify gaps in the community, reduce stigmas, and provide prevention and early intervention. PLE supply encompassing treatment and recovery services, recommend and implement policy and practice changes, mobilize community partnerships, and evaluate services for ongoing improvement.

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
